Whilst school is closed, we want to help you to support your child with their learning as much as you can. We have put a pack together of some resources that will enable your child to continue to develop skills that they have been learning in school.

Things you can work on with your child are:

- Practice correct number and letter formation (using the rhymes to support)
- Reading and writing tricky words. Challenge: can you read or write a sentence with the tricky words?
- Read words where you have to trap the digraph (e.g. 'ow' in cow).
- Write a diary of what you have done whilst at home (some children may wish to extend their sentences using 'and' or 'but').

Remember there are lots of websites and apps that can support your child's learning and they will enjoy. Some are listed on the school website under home learning and the key ones we use in school are listed below.
