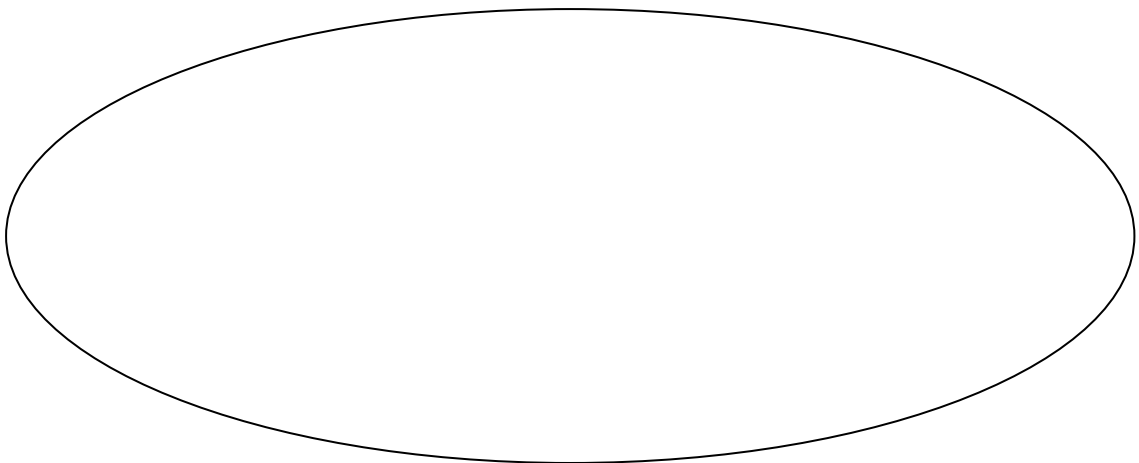
Worksheet 1: Animal families

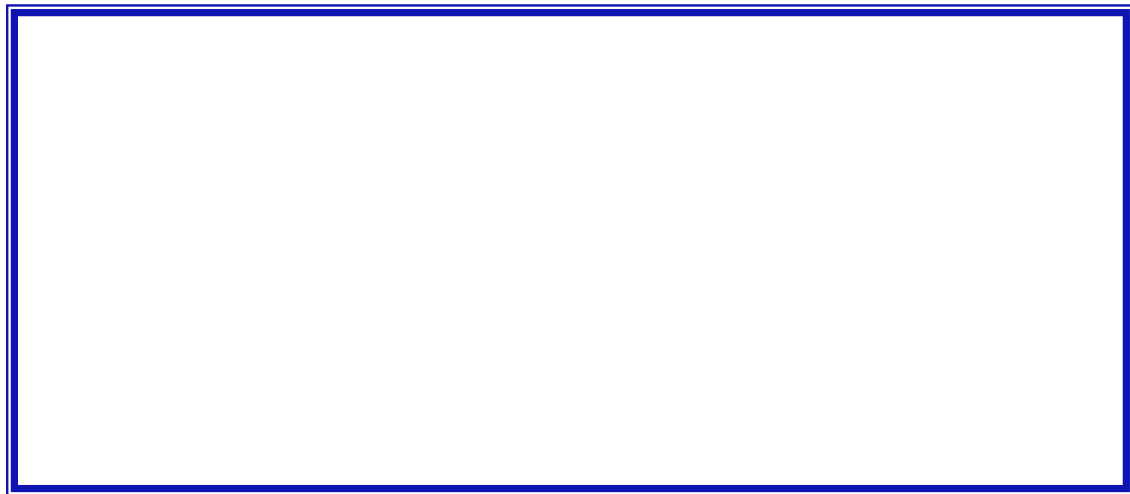
Worksheet 2: The generation game

Most animals go through several stages before they become an adult and are ready to have their own young.



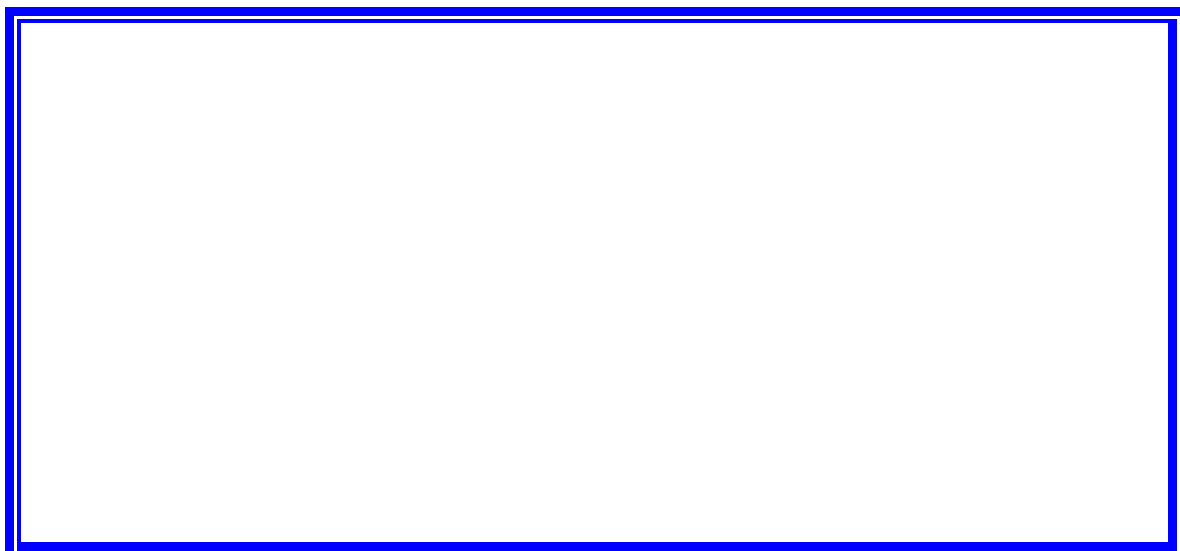
Activity 1

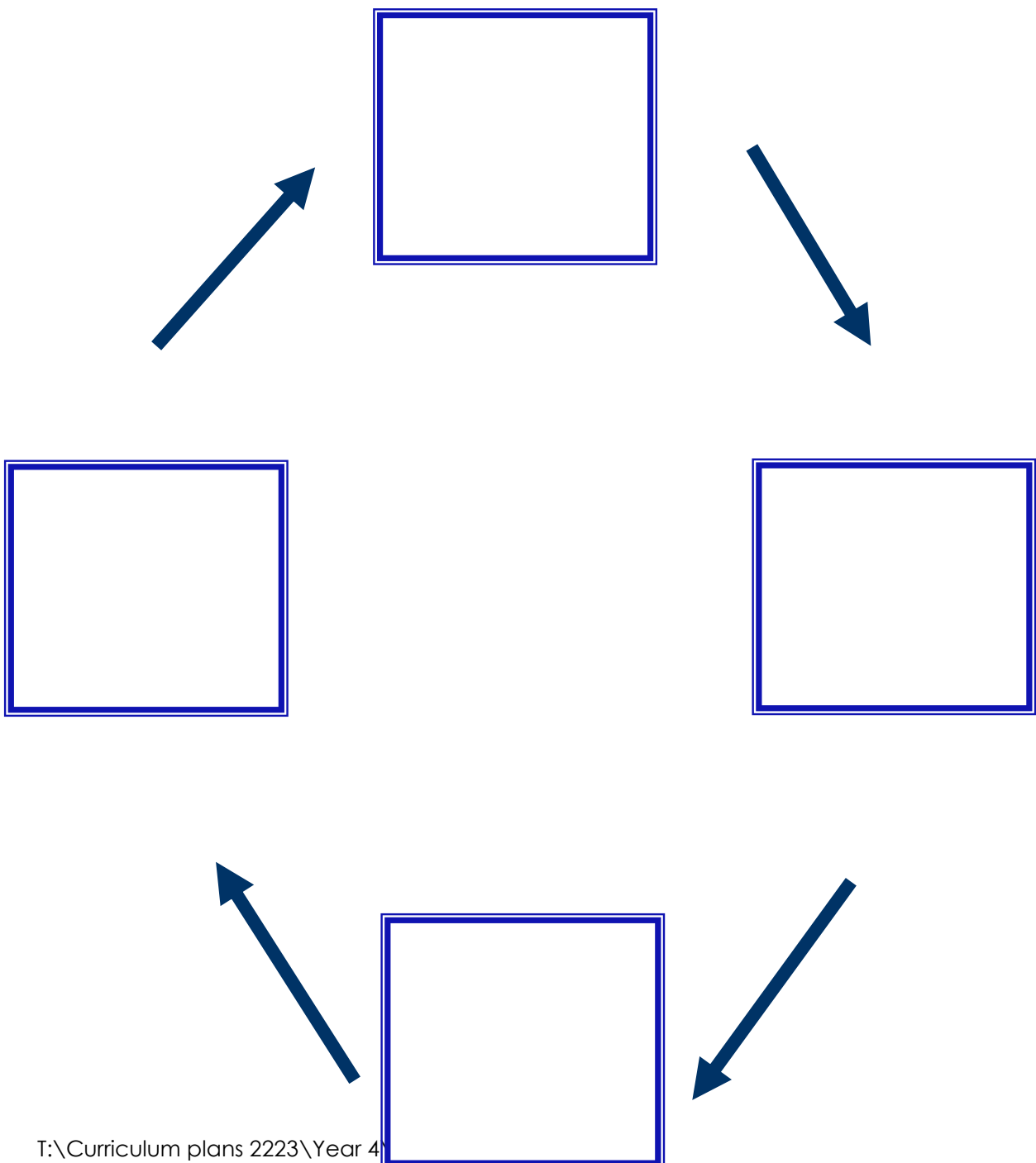


Worksheet 5: The human life cycle
